The Economics Explorer is a national economics competition designed for primary, secondary school and pre-university students, aiming to challenge their knowledge of economics, entrepreneurship, financial literacy and business.

Economics Explorer seeks to ignite a competitive spirit among students by offering them the opportunity to enhance and refine their economic and financial literacy. The competition's questions uniquely highlight economic and financial concepts by connecting them to both local and global economies across different time periods.

The Economics Explorer features multiple-choice tests that require students to apply their economic and financial knowledge to solve problems related to capital resources, the use of financial instruments, and financial market analysis. All questions are specially tailored by expatriates in the economic field.

ACHIEVEMENT OF THE MALAYSIAN TEAM IN THE INTERNATIONAL ECONOMICS OLYMPIAD (IEO) 2025

The International Economics Olympiad (IEO) 2025 was held in Baku, Azerbaijan from 20 July until 29 July 2025 with Malaysia proudly participating once again. This marks Malaysia's eighth consecutive year competing in this prestigious global event. The IEO features two main components, an individual competition, which includes economics and finance tests, and a group competition, which involves a business case presentation. This year, over 200 participants from 52 countries and territories took part. Malaysia's team made the nation proud, with all five students winning medals. In the individual category, they secured three silver medals and two bronze medals:

Silver Medalists: Wong De Xin (Sequoia International School), Sia Yi Ting (Garden International School), Ronan Ooi Shen Yuan (IGB International School). Bronze Medalists: Khow Jin Xen (Sunway College), Raja Zeti Aishah Binti Raja Petra (Kolej Tuanku Ja'afar). In addition to these individual achievements, the team also helped Malaysia achieve a top 10 overall ranking, a remarkable accomplishment on the international stage.

Malaysia also marked a significant milestone by participating for the second time in the Australasian Economics Olympiad (AAEO), held in Sydney, Australia, from 3 to 6 July 2025. Five students proudly represented the country in this emerging competitive arena. The team comprised Jared Goh Wern Hee (Garden International School), Eleanor Eng Yee Hui (Sunway College), Leong Ka Wai (Kolej Tuanku Ja'afar), Yee Sue Wei, and Gan Lih Ying. Although they did not secure any medals, their effort, determination, and resilience were clearly demonstrated as they competed against some of the brightest young minds from across the Asia-Pacific region. Their participation and achievement stands as a testament to their hard work, commitment, and the comprehensive training they underwent, firmly establishing Malaysia as a rising contender in the global landscape of economics competitions.

- Registration for the competition is done by person-in-charge at (https://contesthub.my/register)

- Contest slip for participants will be provided in the Contesthub few days before the competition day
- Ouring the competition period, person-in-charge must conduct the competition at their own venues, invigilated by the person-in-charge
- Person-in-charge are responsible to enforce the standard competition regulations
- The results will be announced in November 2025
- The e-certificate will be provided in the Contesthub

Each participant will receive a certificate of participation. Awards will be given to the top scorers, according to the percentiles as shown below. The awards are symbolic, not an actual medal.


